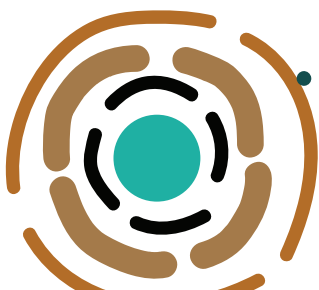

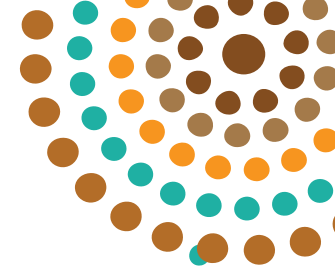
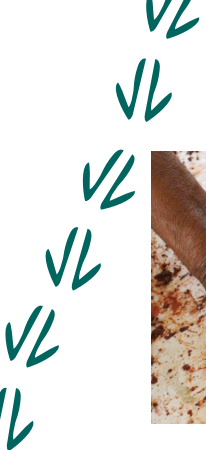

Established in 2004, the Gab Titui Cultural Centre is the gateway to the Torres Strait, and the region's first keeping place for historical artefacts and contemporary Indigenous art. At the Centre, visitors can explore two very distinct galleries showcasing permanent and travelling exhibitions and art displays of cultural identity and storytelling. 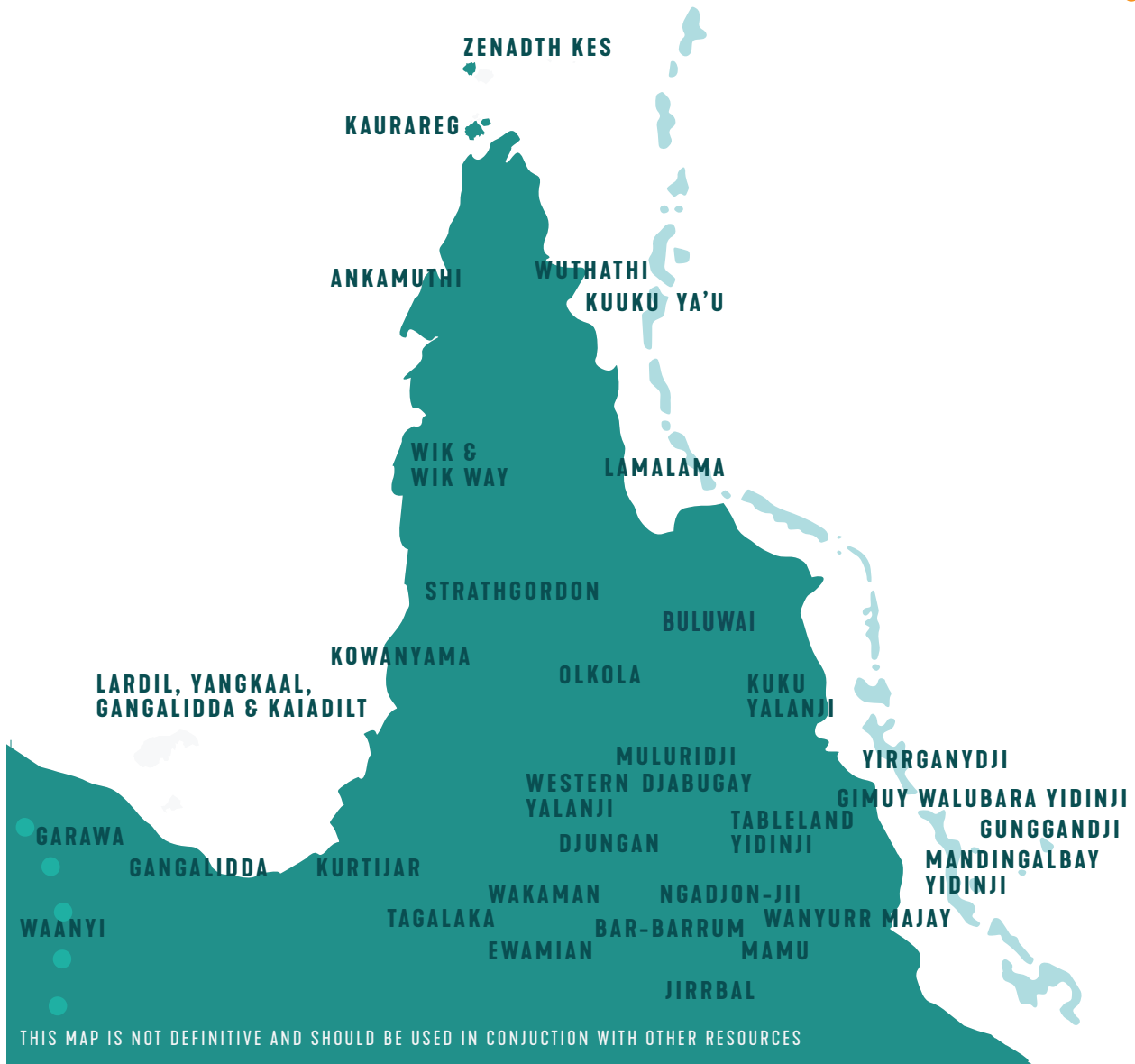
